## Sharing of Joys, News, Concerns

### Opening Prayer (Pastor)

#### \*Call to Worship

*Psalm 118, Matthew 21*

Pastor: When they had come near Jerusalem and had reached Bethphage, at the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two disciples ahead, saying to them, "Go into the village ahead of you, and immediately you will find a donkey tied, and a colt with her; untie them and bring them to me. If anyone says anything to you, just say this, 'The Lord needs them.' And he will send them immediately."

With boughs in hand, join in the festal procession up to the horns of the altar. When he entered Jerusalem, the whole city was in turmoil, asking, "Who is this?" The crowds were saying, "This is the prophet Jesus from Nazareth in Galilee."

**All: Give thanks to the Lord, for God is good. God's steadfast love endures forever!**

All Readers: You are my God, and I will give you thanks; you are my God and I will exalt you.
