

Genesis 1, Mark 1

(Women only) Praise to you, almighty God, creator of the universe. By your breath the world came into being. At your word light broke forth, banishing the darkness. You brought order out of chaos. Night follows day; morning light emerges from the darkness. You created all that is and called it good. And so, we your people join all creation as we praise you, God of glory and strength.

(Men only) You sent John the Baptist into the wilderness, proclaiming forgiveness and preparing the way for the one who would baptize with the Spirit. Jesus was baptized by John, and as the Spirit descended, your voice proclaimed, "You are my son, the beloved; with you I am well pleased." Jesus taught your ways of love and forgiveness.
